

Associate-to-Bachelor's (ATB) Degree Completion Option – ATB2.0: Carroll Community College & Towson University

General Information for the Primarily Online Hybrid Model – Summer Start

I. General Program Information

This dual enrollment option is available to eligible students starting their first year in the Carroll Community College (CCC) Nursing Program. Admission is competitive and based on completed courses, grade point average (GPA), and professional conduct during year one in the CCC Nursing Program. Students will be dually enrolled as degree-seeking students at both CCC and Towson University (TU). ATB2.0 students begin their TU courses the summer term following year one of the CCC Nursing program. Once they earn the Associate of Science (A.S.) degree at CCC

Admission Decisions

The Carroll CC and TU Nursing Department will review completed applications for acceptance into the ATB program. Students will be notified by either email and/or letter with their admission decision. Any offer of admission given will be contingent upon successful completion of currently enrolled nursing courses at SCC. Students will be required to submit an updated transcript after the completion of the spring term to verify their nursing grades.

IV. Tuition, Fees, and Financial Aid

Students will be charged tuition and fees based on the policies of each institution. Tuition and fees are subject to change each academic year. If students are using financial aid, it will be processed through the TU Financial Aid Office based on the total enrollment at both institutions. For the purposes of tuition and financial aid, students must be aware that the ATB program involves part-time enrollment (less than 12 credits) for the majority of the program.
