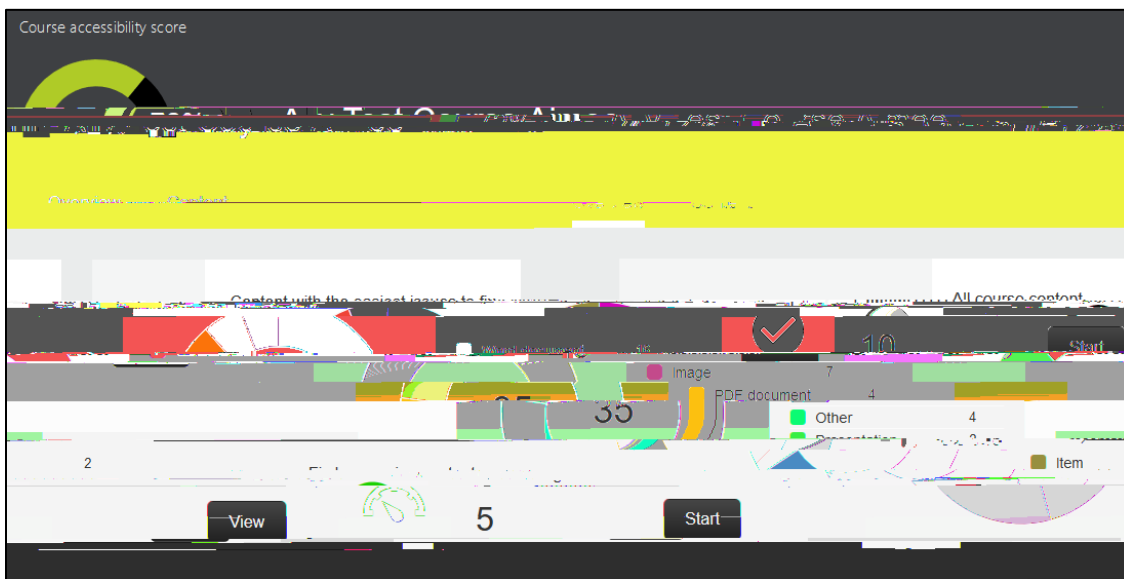
Blackboard Course Accessibility Report

Once Ally has been turned on in your course, you will see indicators next to each document uploaded in your course. To view the accessibility indicators for each document, you can use the Course Accessibility Report. This will provide an accessibility summary and overview at the course level.

At the bottom of the report, you will see a list of all content within your course. You can sort this list by Name or by Issues or Score, either highest to lowest, or lowest to highest. Clicking on the accessibility indicator icon will take you to a page to help remedy any issues for the items.

Beneath these options, you will see a list of all content issues within the course. These issues are listed in order of priority, from Severe to Minor. Clicking on an issue will take you to a list of all content within your course affected by this issue.

On the Content tab, you will see a list of all content within your course. You can sort this list by Name or by Issues or Score, either highest to lowest, or lowest to highest. Clicking on the accessibility indicator icon will take you to a page to help remedy any issues for the items.
